## **Article 9 (Disqualifications of Officers) of the Articles of Incorporation of IBS**

**Article 9 (Disqualifications of Officers)** ① A person who falls under any of the following subparagraphs shall be disqualified from being appointed as an IBS officer.

1. A person to whom any subparagraph of Article 33 of the State Public Officials Act applies
2. A person for whom three years has not passed since being dismissed from an IBS officer position

### **Article 33 (Grounds for Disqualification) of the State Public Officials Act**

No person who falls under any of the following subparagraphs shall be appointed as a public official:

1. An incompetent or quasi-incompetent;
2. A person who was declared bankrupt and has not yet been reinstated;
3. A person in whose case five years have not passed since his/her imprisonment without prison labor or a heavier punishment as declared by a court was completely executed or exempted;
4. A person who was sentenced by the suspension of the execution of imprisonment without prison labor or a heavier punishment and for whom two years have not passed since the period of suspension expired;
5. A person who is under a suspended sentence of imprisonment without prison labor or a heavier punishment as declared by a court;
6. A person who is disqualified, or whose qualification is suspended, pursuant to a judgment of the court or other Acts;
- 6-2. A person who had committed a crime prescribed in Articles 355 and 356 of the Criminal Act with regard to his/her duty during the period of service as public official, and for whom two years have not passed from the time punishment became final and conclusive after being sentenced to a fine not less than three million won;
7. A person who was removed from office by a disciplinary action, and for whom five years have not passed thereafter;
8. A person who was dismissed by a disciplinary action, and for whom three years have not passed thereafter.
