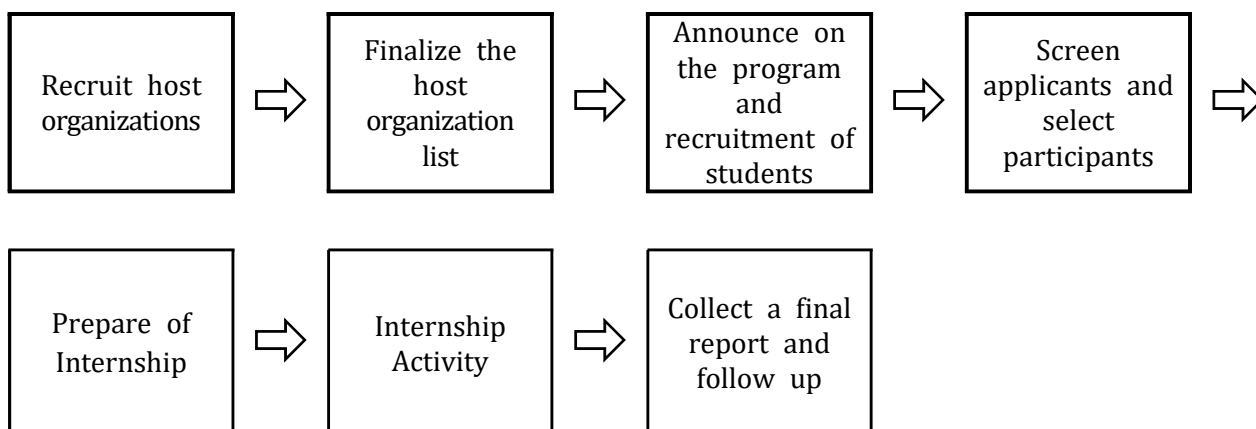

□ **Host Organizations Eligible for Joining the Program**

- **(Eligible Host Organizations)** Public or non-profit research organizations(e.g., Max Planck Institutes, Helmholtz Centers, Fraunhofer Institutes, Leibniz institutes and university-affiliated research laboratories) located in Germany and specialized in physics, chemistry, life science and other branches of science
- **(Requirement for the Host Organizations)** Submit a copy of the application form and a letter signed by the head or deputy head of the organization(department); and (after internship) issue a program participation certificate upon request of interns

□ **Application**

- **(Application Period)** ~ April 25, 2021
- **(How to apply)** Via E-mail
- **(Required documents)** A letter signed by the head or deputy head of the organization(department) and a copy of the application form

* Submission of the letter may be accepted until May 24, 2021 for applicants under unavoidable circumstances.

□ Overview

- **(Eligibility)** Undergraduate or master course students in science and engineering who have Korean nationality
- **(Benefits)** KRW 1.3 million per month for living expenses, the actual cost of airfare, allowance for pre-departure preparation, etc.
 - * Including tax and miscellaneous expense; Additional contributions by host organizations may be possible
- **(Internship Period)** Six-month initial contract; one-year extension to be possible depending on performance (subject to discussion)
- **(Program Schedule)** Planned for the second half of 2021

- **(Selection of Participants)**
 - By reviewing the documents submitted by applicants, MPK and hosting organizations in Germany make a shortlist candidates for interview
 - Interns are finally selected through consultation with the supervising researcher in Germany
 - **(Required Documents)** CV, Personal statement, Certificate of enrollment, Academic transcript, Certificate of an English fluency test result and A Document for the Agreement on the Provision and Usage of Personal Information
 - * A certificate of an English fluency test result is not required for applicants who live or attend college abroad
 - **(Follow-Up)** After internship, submit a final report including internship activities, results, achievements and further plans and etc.
