1. Overview

Purpose

To expand global research collaboration through Brain Circulation networks by organizing technology exchange conferences in key fields of research for domestic and international scholars, mid-career and young scientists, and to promote the expansion of domestic and international networks of human resources and the leap towards becoming a global talent hub.

- * Core technology areas indispensable for enhancing national R&D capacity and global network can be taken into consideration.
- ♦ Venue: 1 Geographically isolated region in Korea (To be determined)
- ♦ Period: June ~ Mid December 2023 (2 days & 3 nights or 3 nights & 4 days per meeting)
- ♦ Scale: Approx. 30 participants per meeting
 - Two reputable Organizers (one from Korean scientists, and the other from foreign or overseas Korean scientists) entrusted with authority
 - 5~6 speakers from abroad, approx. 10 domestic speakers, mid and early career scientists, approx. 10 Post Doc., graduates and undergraduates
 - * For global networking, we recommend the inclusion of foreign speakers from various countries.

Program Composition

- Develop a free-form program that meets the characteristics of the respective technology
- Inclusion of activities such as group discussion is encouraged in order to promote active communication and exchange among participants.

Intended Participants

- (Domestic) government-funded research institutes, national research institutes, universities, university-affiliated research institutes, academic societies in science and engineering fields, non-profit foundations, corporate-affiliated research institutes, etc.
- (Overseas) Overseas Korean Scientists and Engineers Associations, Overseas
 Professional Branch Associations

2. Application Eligibility

Eligibility

- Proposal submitted by 2 Organizers* (One domestic and one foreign or overseas Korean scientists)
 - * An Organizer is an outstanding S&T expert from home and abroad who can organize and preside over X-Lab Day with experience of years of R&D
 - * Those who applied for X-Lab Day 2022 are eligible as well.

Responsibility of Organizers

- o Developing a program and organizing participants for X-Lab Day
- o Contact liaison with potential co-organizer (foreign or overseas Korean scientist)
- \circ Selecting areas and topics for the X-Lab Day event
- o Proceeding the X-Lab Day and come up with an outcome report of the meetings

Covered Expenses

- The whole expenses incurred during the stay for the purpose of participating in BrainLink X-Lab Day (No registration fee)
 - (Domestic participants) speakers honorarium, expenses incurred for accommodation, dining, etc.
 - (Overseas participants) speakers round-trip airfare*, honorarium, expenses

incurred for accommodation, dining, etc.

* Business class travel will be provided for up to 4 overseas invited speakers(including a foreign organizer) who are of distinguished scholars, while economy class travel will be provided for all other individuals.


Method

 - Proposal
 - CVs of organizers and overseas invited speakers
 - Consent form for Collection and Use of personal information

Note

- When submitting a proposal, be sure to attach the seal of the applying institution's head.
- After the selection of the technology exchange conference, changes to invited overseas speakers (including organizers) are not allowed. Any changes to invited speakers will result in a reassessment, and the selection may be canceled.
- If an invited overseas speaker is a distinguished scholar, be sure to indicate this in the proposal.
- o All participants are expected to attend the entire day of the event
- In the selection of the BrainLink X-Lab Day, priority will be given to the linkage with the 1st Global Korean Scientists and Engineers Conference*.
 - Before and after the technology exchange conference, it is possible to participate in the 1st Global Korean Scientists and Engineers Conference as a presenter or discussant.
 - * This conference is expected to attract over 3,000 Korean scientists and engineers from around the world as the largest exchange forum for Korean scientists and engineers. (July 4-7, 2023/Korea Science and Technology Center)
